Position Description: OTR Driver, Truckload

MAJOR DUTIES:

- Transport and deliver freight over the road over long distances in a safe, efficient, timely and legal manner.
- Hook and unhook trailers; secure freight; install and remove tire chains as required by weather, tarp and un-tarp freight if operating flatbeds.
- Load and unload trailers and perform lifting, pulling, pushing and carrying freight.
- Complete all necessary paperwork and maintain records required under state and federal laws and regulations.
- Ensure that all operations are in compliance with state and federal laws and regulations.
- Perform routine inspection and preventative maintenance on assigned equipment and refer defects/repairs to Company personnel.
- Represent the Company and the trucking industry in a professional manner.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

- Valid Commercial Driver's License
- One-year previous tractor/trailer driving experience (unless applying as a Student Driver)
- Knowledge of all applicable DOT Regulations and Motor Carrier Safety Regulations
- Meet all standards (medical, safety, etc.) required by the DOT and pass required drug/alcohol test, including a Company-required hair follicle test
- Acceptable background investigation results.

Physical Requirements:

- The Dictionary of Occupational Titles classifies Tractor-Trailer Truck Driver in the Medium physical demand level.
- Code of Federal Regulations § 404.1567 defines Medium level work as work that involves lifting no more than 50 pounds at a time with frequent lifting or carrying of objects weighing up to 25 pounds.
- Able to be away from home for extended periods of time, available for round-the-clock trips and able to remain alert while driving for periods of up to 11 hours
- Able to squat, crouch and reach as needed; able to enter and exit the vehicle's cab numerous times each day
- Must be able to work in severe weather conditions—both heat and cold.
