According to the **National Frozen & Refrigerated Foods Association** (NFRA) refrigeration sales have increased by 32% over the past five years. Similarly, in 2023, the U.S. fruit and vegetable market reached **<u>\$66.7 billion</u>**, up from \$63.4 billion in 2022.

The increased demand for perishable goods, like refrigerated items and produce, means the need for temperature-controlled carriers and refrigerated freight services is on the rise. This has also led to an uptick in cross-border shipping, with the U.S. relying on regions like Mexico for extended growing seasons to meet rising produce demands. 2022 produce imports from Mexico to the U.S. totaled an estimated \$18.7 billion, including fresh, frozen and processed fruits, vegetables and nuts. Fresh produce imports from Mexico are expected to reach a total economic impact of \$53 billion by 2030.

These trends underscore the need for cross-border freight services, but it's essential for companies to adapt to fully meet rising demand. Cross-border freight has unique obstacles, including shifting regulations, differing taxes and fees, and competing documentation and inspection requirements.
